# Diversified **SERVICES**

The service portfolio at Bass Maintenance is designed to meet all of our clients' new construction and maintenance needs. This portfolio can be divided into four service areas: Mechanical, Civil / Structural / Architectural, Equipment Installation, Hydro Blasting / Painting / Sand Blasting.

## **1** Mechanical
